Dear Judge Bedell:

As the Court will recall, by Order dated February 10, 2011, the Court approved an initial cash payment of \$200 to Medical Monitoring Class members who register and have their membership in the Class verified (the "Verified Registrants"), with the balance of the available \$3 million total amount available for Medical Monitoring Verified Registrant cash payments, if any, to be paid at the end of registration period based upon the number of Verified Registrants. As observed in the Court's Order, this cash payment level assured adequate reserves for up to 15,000 Verified Registrants.

As the second month of Medical Monitoring registration ends, we have received forms from approximately 2,200 Medical Monitoring registrants, with approximately 800 having been verified thus far. The first 1,000 were received during the first two weeks, with 1,200 being received in six weeks, indicating a steep decline in the registration rate. Based upon this registration rate, we project that the total number of Medical Monitoring registrants will be less than 6,600.

Accordingly, we submit that a more appropriate Medical Monitoring Verified Registrant cash payment is \$400, with \$450 being the amount needed to pay approximately 6,600 Verified Registrants, and with this amount being reduced by 10% because it is reasonably foreseeable that the registration rate may increase.

**FINAL ORDER INCREASING MEDICAL MONITORING VERIFIED REGISTRANT
CASH PAYMENT FROM \$200 TO \$400**

Presently before the Court is the Claims Administrator's request to increase the Medical Monitoring Verified Registrant cash payment from \$200 to \$400, based upon the registration rate experienced in the first two months of the six month Medical Monitoring Program registration period.

After a careful review of the Claims Administrator's submission, and in consideration of the applicable law, the Court **ORDERS** that the proposal is hereby **APPROVED** and shall be carried out during the administration of the Settlement. Medical Monitoring Verified Registrants who have previously received a \$200 cash payment shall receive the additional \$200 cash payment as soon as possible, and future cash Medical Monitoring Verified Registrant payments shall equal \$400, pending further Orders of this Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.






