FINAL ORDER APPROVING AGREEMENT FOR THE ROAD REPAVING/REPAIR
PORTION OF THE SETTLEMENT ROAD REPAIR AND IMPROVEMENT
PROGRAM BETWEEN THE PERRINE DUPONT SETTLEMENT
AND J.F. ALLEN COMPANY

Presently before the Court is the Claims Administrator's April 12, 2016 Report, which recommends that the proposed Agreement for the Road Repaving/Repair Portion of the Settlement Road Improvement Program with J.F. Allen Company (the "Road Repair Program Agreement"), be approved by this Court.

After a careful review of the Claims Administrator's Report, the Court notes that there were 2 bidders, whose bid amounts were within less than \$2,000 of each other, and with the bid of J.F. Allen Company being \$243,348.70. Therefore, the bid amount was not the sole criteria for selecting the successful bidder. After interviewing both bidders and exercising due diligence, the Claims Administrator has recommended that J.F. Allen Company be selected by the Court. The selection of J. F. Allen Company to perform the services in connection with the Settlement Road Repaving/Repair portion of the Settlement Road Improvement Program is hereby approved by this Court.

In consideration of applicable law, the Court **ORDERS** that the proposed Road Repair Program Agreement is hereby **APPROVED** and that the Claims Administrator, on behalf of the

Perrine DuPont Settlement, is hereby **AUTHORIZED, EMPOWERED** and **DIRECTED** to enter into the Road Repair Program Agreement on behalf of the Settlement, with the Claims Administrator's execution and delivery of the Road Repair Program Agreement to J.F. Allen Company, to be conclusively presumed to be the valid and binding act of the Settlement.

Lastly, pursuant to Rule 54(b) of the West Virginia Rules of Civil Procedure, the Court directs entry of this Order as a Final Order as to the claims and issues above upon an express determination that there is no just reason for delay and upon an express direction for the entry for judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




