





No inquiry or objection concerning our proposed Accounting was lodged.



PROPOSED 2014 ANNUAL FIDUCIARY ACCOUNTING FOR THE

AND APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER APPROVING THE ACCOUNTING

TO THE HONORABLE THOMAS A. BEDELL,  
CIRCUIT JUDGE OF HARRISON COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, IN CAMERA:

COMES NOW, Edgar C. Gentle, III, the Claims Administrator of the Perrine-DuPont Medical Monitoring Qualified Settlement Fund (the "Medical Fund"), and, pursuant to the terms of the November 19, 2010 Memorandum of Understanding, which led to the establishment of the Medical Fund, entered into by Settling Plaintiffs' Counsel and Settling Defendants' Counsel, hereby (i) submits the following proposed 2014 Annual Fiduciary Accounting for the Medical Fund, and (ii) requests an Order approving the 2014 Annual Fiduciary Accounting for the Medical Fund and granting a judicial settlement of account. In support thereof, the Claims Administrator respectfully submits the following report of his acts and doings in such fiduciary capacity for the Medical Fund for the year ended December 31, 2014.


Please find enclosed the Medical Fund's 2014 Financial Statement. The Financial Statement consists of (i) a Balance Sheet of the Medical Fund at December 31, 2014 in Schedule I; and (ii) a Schedule of Receipts Collected, Expenses Paid and Changes in Fund Balance of the Medical Fund for the year ended December 31, 2014 (the "Year") in Schedule II. Additionally, the Claims Administrator Disbursement Ledgers for the Year are also provided for the Medical Fund's Pre-Implementation and Post-Implementation Date Funding checking accounts.

As the Schedule of Receipts Collected, Expenses Paid and Changes in Fund Balance of the Medical Fund indicates, on an accrual basis Medical Fund expenditures totaled \$489,640 during the Year, of which: (a) \$386,074 was attributable to direct expenses of the Medical Monitoring Program, and (b) \$103,566 was attributable to expenses associated with the administration of the Medical Fund. Therefore, during the Year, 78.85% of Medical Fund expenditures were attributable to direct expenses of the Medical Monitoring Program, and 21.15% of Medical Fund expenditures were attributable to expenses associated with the administration of the Medical Fund.

Also, during the Year, the Medical Fund's investment and other interest bearing accounts generated a net gain of **\$2,422** on an accrual basis of accounting, for a total annualized yield of **approximately 0.17%**.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Claims Administrator respectfully requests entry of an Order judicially settling and approving his 2014 Annual Fiduciary Accounting for the Medical Fund and thereby discharging the Claims Administrator from any and all liability as to any matter disclosed in the 2014 Annual Fiduciary Accounting.
